Terms and Conditions

1. All applicants must be over the age of 18.

Reservations and payment

- 2. Reservations must be made at least three calendar months before the course begins, along with a 100 pound deposit.
- 3. In order to ensure a place on a Grecophone course, it is necessary to make payment in full two months before your course begins. Cheques must clear by this date.
- 4. After this date we are only able to make full refunds in exceptional circumstances such as ill health or bereavement. Proof will, however, be required and these are the only cases in which a refund will be considered. (Deposit not refundable)
- 5. In the case of emergencies, Grecophone reserves the right to cancel courses before they have commenced. Should this occur, customers will receive a full refund.
- 6. Our fees include 3 hours of tuition per weekday, 7 nights accommodation and 2 meals per day.

Transport and accommodation

- 7. It is the responsibility of the client to arrange all transport to and from Kavala bus terminal, from where he or she will be collected. Full directions and instructions as well as details of bus connections will be given upon confirmation.
